Please note that this is <u>NOT</u> a comprehensive list. Given the wide variety of questions that fall into those categories, this chart only includes those subject areas that may be of the greatest interest to students. You are encouraged to review the bar exam application you are interested in to confirm the full scope of what is asked on that application. This chart is updated biannually, but you must still check the questions applicable in your jurisdiction as this list may not be up to date or exhaustive.
